














#### The Best of the Best

The Elite Amateur Cup is a points race by competing in the seven historic Elite Amateur Golf Series (EAGS) championships.

#### Race To the Finish Line

#### **HOW IT WORKS:**

Elite Amateur Cup point system is the cumulative total of World Amateur Golf Ranking® (WAGR) points earned from competing in the seven EAGS events. The Elite Amateur Cup winner is the player with the most points at the end of the series that culminates with the Western Amateur.

#### **EXEMPTIONS AND AWARDS:**

Top finishers in the series earn exemptions into USGA Championships, PGA TOUR, and Korn Ferry Tour events. A player must compete in a minimum of three events to be eligible to receive exemptions. Point standings will be updated weekly on Wednesday during the series.




